The masked weapons of destruction...

Ephesians 4:26; Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:

James 3:14, 16; But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.

Bitterness:

Luke 12:15; And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.

1st Samuel 15:23; For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee

from being king.

Covetousness / Idolatry:

Covetousness / Idolatry (continuation): Colossians 3:5; 8; Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth. ----- Envy, Proverbs 27:4; 23:17; Wrath is cruel, and anger is outrageous; but who is able to stand before envy? Let not thine heart envy sinners: but be thou in the fear of the LORD all the day long. Matt.27:18; For he knew that for envy they had delivered him. Acts 13:45; But when the Jews saw the multitudes, they were filled with envy, and spake against those things which were spoken by Paul, contradicting and blaspheming. ----- Grudge; James 5:9; Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest ye be condemned: behold, the judge standeth before the door. Leviticus 19:18; Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD. 1st Peter 4:9; Use hospitality one to another without grudging.

Colossians 3:8; But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth.

Eph. 4:31; Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

Malice:

1st Peter 2:1- 2; Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings, As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk

of the word, that ye may grow thereby:

Idle words: Matt. 12:36-37; But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned. Eph.4:29; Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers. 1st Cor. 15:33; Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

Rom. 13:14; But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof.

Titus 3:2-7; To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men. For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived servina

Solution:

divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared. Not by

works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost:

Solution (continuation): Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour: That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. ----- Heb. 12:2-4; Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds. Ye have not yet resisted unto blood, striving against sin. ----- SCROLL #39 - (Rev. 20:11-15) He who occupies this seat is the all seeing Lord, the eternal Godhead. He sits in his dreadfulness and his dramatic almightiness, ready to judge. The explosive light of truth flashes forth. The books are opened. Heaven certainly keeps books: one of the good deeds and one for the bad deeds. The bride does not come under judgment but her deeds are recorded.
