

# THE SECRET TO THE NEEDFUL IN LIFE

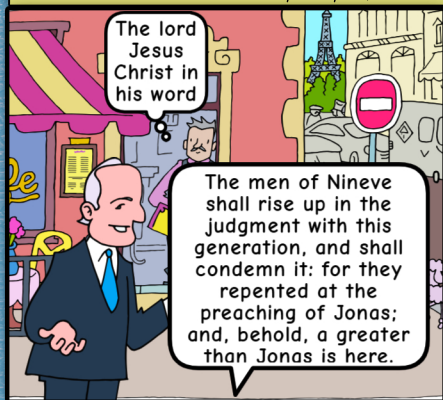

One thing is needful (absolute necessity); and Mary not Martha hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her; - the Word: John 1:14



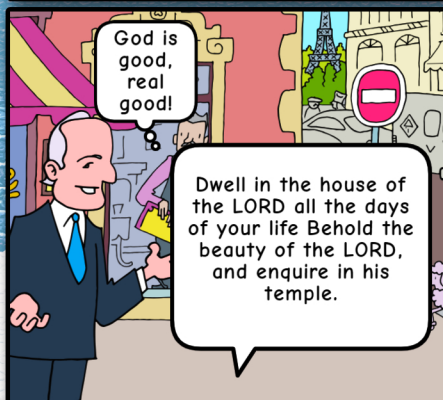

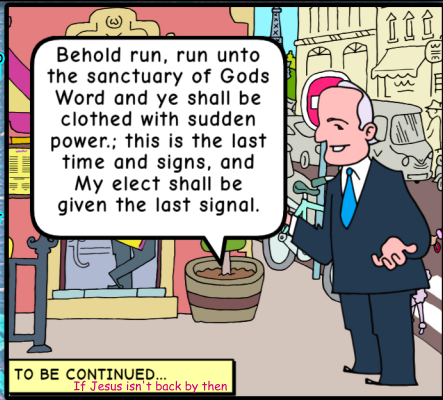

Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this.
