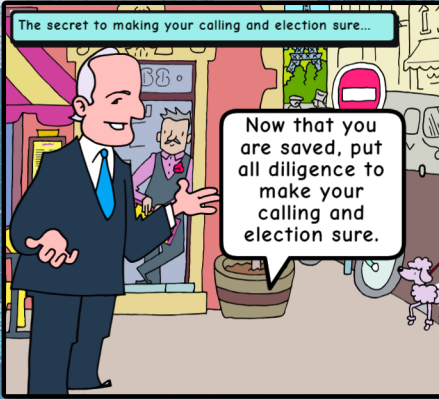


THE SECRET TO MAKING YOUR CALLING AND ELECTION SURE

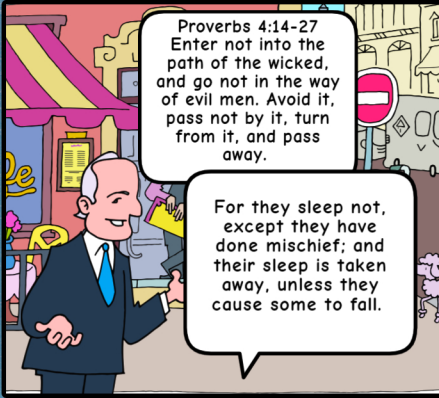
Now that you are saved, put all diligence to make your calling and election sure.

Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of Jesus our Lord

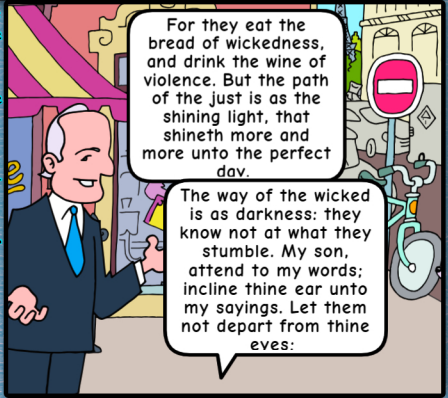

And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity. ----- 2nd Tim. 2:15: Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

For they sleep not, except they have done mischief; and their sleep is taken away, unless they cause some to fall.

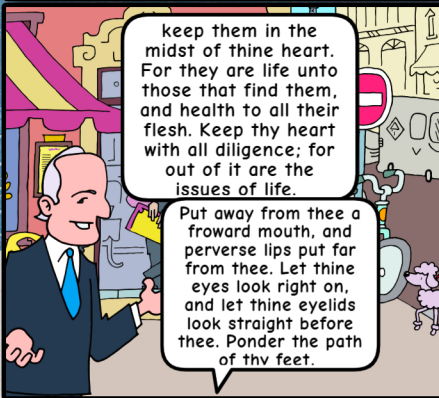
